Please engage thoughtfully and meaningfully with the information you've read. We expect you to dig in and wrestle with the content from each book. Reflect on what you've learned, how the book impacted you, what questions have come up in you while reading, and conclusions you're coming to in light of the material. Write what you've uncovered.

FORMAT:

700-900 words, 1.5 spacing, stapled, with 12-point font. Please include a cover page with your title, full name, revival group pastor, intern and date. Word count is required at the bottom of the last page.

QUESTIONS TO PONDER:

The following questions are optional. They are intended to stir your thoughts for writing but are not required in your material.

- How did reading this book stir your heart toward God?
- How do you cultivate a life that hungers and thirsts after the Lord?
Why is this important?
- It is almost impossible to read Tozer and not begin to feel a deep thirst for the things of the Lord. What do you think you should do to steward a personal response to God's prompting?
- Tozer makes pursuing God such a deep, personal and intimate exchange of hearts. Did this challenge you in any way?

Please describe.

- How do you think we take hold of the “more” of the Lord while here on earth?
- Tozer writes with unique depth and intellect, requiring the heart, mind, and spirit to be present as you read. Did his approach challenge or inspire you in any way? Please describe.
