Kris Vallotton continues his discussion on women in the church. The church of Corinth, Timothy, and Peter actually empower women, not oppress them!

Sanctification in Purity

Dann Farrelly talks about how sanctification and purity are a part of every believer's life, no matter what their circumstances are.

Plan for Purity

Kris Vallotton talks about the importance of purity and the battle to protect it. Sex was created by God to be enjoyed in the covenant of marriage. Kris also shares practical steps for creating a purity plan.

Building Strong Relationships Together

Dann Farrelly discusses the various types of relationships believers can experience. It is our responsibility to build healthy, strong love bonds with one another.

The Choice of Relationships

Dann Farrelly talks about the various phases of relationships between men and women.

Roles of Men in Society

Kris Vallotton discusses the role of men in society. Men give society identity, a purpose, and plan. Fathers live for a legacy and create an infrastructure to empower the purpose of family members.

Banning Liebscher talks about how you are supposed to be intentional in your life and not just passionate. You have to bring the right ingredients into your life in order to live it to the fullest.

Fundamental Perspectives of God

Eric Johnson talks about the different types of relationships a person can have with God. We are called to be His friends, and pruning is not punishment!

Watch and Pray

Bill Johnson shares how prayer can affect your life. Through prayer, Jesus gives you a way to avoid sin and come into alignment with God.

Start Your Own Fire

Steve & Wendy Backlund talk about the importance of aligning your mind with the truth. You will learn how to practically speak truth and identity over yourself and how to use the truth as a weapon against strongholds.

When Sons and Daughters Become Heroes

Paul Manwaring shares what it would look like when sons and daughters become heroes. In order to build great heroes, you have to be great mothers and fathers.

The Power of Worship

Brian Johnson speaks on how worship can transform our lives. Worship is saying God is worthy and worth more anything else.

Releasing Peace

Bill Johnson teaches on the normal life of a believer. He was raised in death so you could live a normal life of victory and release peace wherever you go!

Kris Vallotton reviews previous discussions about purity and sexuality, then opens the floor for questions related to purity and sexuality.

Moral Revolution Directors, Cole and Caitlin Zick, share their stories in regards to their sexual pasts. Cole shares about holiness and how it is an invitation into what is possible for your present and future, not to bring condemnation over your past.

Sex & Your Story

Caitlin Zick shares about the different ways people are taught about sex. It makes a difference when and how you are introduced to sex and it is important to know your own story.

Sex In Today's Culture

Cole Zick shares how what you surround yourself with impacts your view on sex. Sex is not wrong and was created for bonding within marriage.

Stewarding Increase

Bill Johnson talks about how it's important for believers to think differently than the world. It's your job to increase what the Lord has given you and steward gifts from the Lord.

Recognizing the Tactics of the Enemy

Bill Johnson opens with fifteen minutes of praise and adoration to the Lord. Bill then shares three tactics of the enemy to derail believers and what to watch out for.

Love that Wins

Kris Vallotton discusses the definition of God's true love and how this love manifests in the world in ways that go beyond your understanding.

Stewarding Your Responsibilities

Believers are called to carry each other's burdens, but not each other loads. Havilah Cunningham shares how you can be responsible for your own life and carry your own load.

The Apostolic Wineskin

Kris Vallotton teaches about the symbolism of having a fresh wineskin in place that can hold new wine. He teaches about the importance of putting flexible leadership in place where the Presence of God has a place to expand and grow, so it can affect the way people live and think.

A New Apostolic Season

Kris Vallotton begins his discussion on denominationalism vs apostleships. It is your job to be an apostle and equip people, not to move in denominationalism and gather people.

Moving in Apostleship, Part One

Kris Vallotton begins teaching on moving away from denominationalism and into apostleships. He discusses the roles of apostles to change culture and how the role of an apostle can be distinguished from the role of a pastor.

Moving in Apostleship, Part Two

Kris Vallotton adds the finishing thoughts to his message, “Moving into Apostleship, Part One.” He talks about the role of an apostle to build structures that empower people as saints instead of leading them as though they were still sinners under the old covenant. At the end of this message Kris opens the session up for a time of Q&A.

More Than Your Gifting

Bill Johnson talks about the journey of growing and exploring your potential in the kingdom of God. Being aware of your gifts is important, but if you limit yourself to what you are thinking, you miss out on the best part of life. Additionally, the speaker answers unrelated questions from the crowd.

Practical Keys to Sharing the Gospel

Chris Overstreet shares practical keys to sharing the Gospel of Jesus Christ. He finishes his message with ten approaches to share Jesus with others.

Kingdom Foundations 2019: Truth - Reality as God Knows it, Parts 1 & 2

Dann Farrelly goes over the Kingdom Foundations: Truth, Reality as God Knows It. In Part One, Dann teaches that truth is absolute because God is absolute, and your reality of life should reflect truth as God knows it to be. In the second part, Dann looks at how your Christian faith influences and shapes how you see truth, and he challenges you to be ready to give an answer for the truth you believe.

Job, Part One

Dann Farrelly goes into the theology found in the book of Job. He goes into depth about Job's life and the context of culture in Job's lifetime.

Job, Part Two

Dann Farrelly continues his discussion on the Book of Job and the season of suffering Job went through. The Book of Job was just a season in his life, it was not his lifetime.

The Wisdom Texts

Dann Farrelly shares about the Wisdom texts of the Old Testament. He also discusses the different styles of wisdom literature and gives tips to understanding the context.

Biblical Poetry

BSSM dean, Dann Farrelly, leads the class through key poetic characteristics in three different psalms that open up for more accurate and emotionally engaging interpretations. The Lord is an artist and a skilled writer, which makes linguistic studies of scripture valuable. The speaker ends with a corporate charge to read the bible with the Holy Spirit and transition well out of the BSSM environment.

Formation of the Gospels

Dann Farrelly shares his insights about how the Gospels were formed. Imperfect people can create perfect works, and the Gospel writers had the genius of the Holy Spirit working through them.

The Hope of the Book of Revelation

Dann Farrelly goes through the different theories on the Book of Revelation. Our victory is certain in the victory of the lamb. In God, the worst things are never the last things.

Ancient Worship Songs

Dann Farrelly talks about ancient worship songs and how they still impact believers today. He teaches about the humanity, poetry and imagery that can be found in the Psalms.

Posturing Your Heart for Transformation

Bill Johnson talks about the attitude and condition of your heart. He also discusses remaining in a heart posture that will attract the voice of God and bring about transformation in your life.

The Power of Generosity

In this teaching Kris Vallotton shares the importance of being generous and tithing. Kris explains some important kingdom principles which you can see in the Bible related to having a heart to give.

Drawing Near in Uncertain Times

Bill Johnson teaches from Psalm 91 and John 15 and 16. He encourages believers to stay connected and focused to the Source in times where the world or circumstances might be vying for your attention.

Humility is the Way Forward

Kris Vallotton discusses the difference between true humility and false humility. He talks about the various ways you can see the fruit of humility in your personal life and how God's heart is to exalt those who maintain a heart posture of humility.

Fire, Freedom, Breakthrough, No Limits!

Steve and Wendy Backlund share the importance of valuing joy and laughter in your life. Laugh at the lies you have believed and you will see breakthroughs happen in your life and the lives of people around you.

Living Like Jesus

Chris Cruz talks about the importance of becoming like Jesus in every aspect of your being. You need to not only operate in the gifts of the Spirit, but be transformed by the Spirit.

The Word as a Weapon

Havilah Cunnington shares about being alert to the enemy's plans. You must choose which kingdom to follow, and Jesus didn't fight the enemy by using His prophetic words, He fights the enemy by telling the enemy what was written. Havilah shares practical tools on how to fight with the spoken word of God.

Stewarding the Anointing

Bill Johnson shares how to steward the anointing you have been given. When you steward the little God has given you, more will be given. If you discount what God gives you, it will be taken away.

The Power of Peace

Chris Gore discusses the power of being aware of the Prince of Peace living inside of you, so you can shift the atmosphere around you. It's about being in union with Christ.

Authority in Spiritual Realms

Kris Vallotton talks about your apostolic spiritual metron and realms of authority that you can operate in. He discusses how to recognize differences between governmental and spiritual authority, and the importance of being submitted to authority.

Born to Be Courageous

Bill Johnson discusses the importance of supernatural courage. The lifestyle of courage causes the significance of God's design, that He put in another person, to come to the surface. Your courage can cause people to become hungry for God in ways they've never been hungry before.

The Building Blocks of Leadership

Kris Vallotton talks about how to build an organization by answering the questions; who? why? what? how? when? He also discusses the importance of breaking down the big vision into smaller and more achievable goals for the people you are leading.

Michael Koulianos from Jesus Image speaks about the passion required to follow Jesus. Power has nothing to do with the volume of your voice, but has to do with the weight of your voice.

Keeping Your Fire
